Dear Friends of the Caddie Scholarship Fund,

I am pleased to report to you at the beginning of my term as president of this wonderful organization. I have been associated with the WGACSF since 2010, as the fund representative from Tamarack Country Club, and subsequently as a board member and Management Committee member. My own commitment to the fund is renewed each year at our scholarship interviews, when we meet these exceptional candidates and see firsthand how meaningful our awards are.

By the numbers, we awarded new scholarships this past year to 73 deserving young men and women. The Fund is now providing annual scholarships totaling over one million dollars to 271 current students from 65 area clubs for the 2018-19 academic year.

Thanks to the efforts of our immediate past president, Ben Kirschenbaum, and our newly formed Management Committee, the CSF has completed its first season incorporating some significant changes to its operation.

We are pleased to further our program in cooperation with the Evans Scholarship Foundation. Five of our local caddies have been awarded a full-ride Westchester Evans Scholarship beginning in September 2019.

There are currently eleven Westchester Evans Scholars attending schools across the country. The local CSF organizations from from the Metropolitan Area have formed a task force to find additional ways that our associations, with Evans, can benefit our young men and women.

Our administration arrangement with the MGA and MGA Foundation has thus far proved successful in making us more efficient both financially and functionally, which is consistent with our mandate as a not-for-profit organization. The creation of a CSF Management Committee has made us more nimble in the decision making process.

Johanna Gavin became our new Senior Director last January. She has hit the ground running, using her substantial experience as the Director of the New Jersey State Golf Association Caddie Scholarship Fund from 2012 until her appointment as Senior Director of our fund. She is directing the operation of both the WGA Caddie Scholarship Fund as well as the Long Island Golf Association Caddie Scholarship Fund with the assistance of Hilary Barrueco our Scholarship Program Administrator and John O'Brien, our new Manager of Fundraising and Development.

Our goal is to remain focused on the fundraising process which provides the resources for our scholarship awards. We had a successful season last year with our Pro-Am at Century Country Club, Marathon at Knollwood Country Club, Friends of the Fund at Hudson National Golf Club and our 3rd Annual Christopher C. Hickey Invitational at the Country Club of Darien. Thanks to the members and staff of all those clubs for welcoming us and producing great events. Our alumni event was unfortunately a casualty of the weather this year but will be back bigger and better in 2019.

We have had a nice boost to our Endowed Scholarships already this year; notably Bob J. Thomas from within our organization has created a new endowed scholarship fund and the George Russ Memorial named scholarship has advanced to an endowed scholarship.

In addition to our regular fundraising efforts, the CSF staff will begin actively reaching out to our member clubs this season to raise awareness of the fund and the benefits we provide to our caddies and others "in service to golf". With these efforts we hope to increase club participation. We have a fine record of contributions to our fund, but we believe it can be better as we get our message out.

As we begin the season, we are committed to increasing our fundraising efforts and to encouraging more youth participation in local caddie programs.

I sincerely thank you all for your past and hopefully continued support of this great cause.

OUR MISSION

The WGA Caddie Scholarship Fund (CSF) fosters the core values of personal responsibility, integrity and perseverance by giving young men and women in service to golf the opportunity to further enhance their lives through the pursuit of higher education. The Fund provides college scholarships to qualified candidates based on financial need.

OUR HISTORY

The WGA Caddie Scholarship Fund was established in 1956 by renowned amateur golfer Willie P. Turnesa and his good friend Udo Reinach. With 2,737 recipients since its founding, the Caddie Scholarship Fund has provided in excess of \$21,000,000 in scholarship funding.

OUR SCHOLARSHIPS

The CSF is one of the largest organizations of its kind in the nation. Caddie scholarship awards range from \$1,000 to \$10,000 per year for undergraduate study or for study at an accredited trade school. Maximum awards are reserved for exceptional students with exceptional need.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must demonstrate financial need, have applied to or currently attend an accredited school, and have worked a minimum of two seasons in service to golf at a local club in Westchester and other surrounding counties in NY and CT. Service to golf includes caddieing, golf course maintenance, and work in the golf shop, bag room or on the practice range. Club members and their children are not eligible to apply.

FUNDING

The CSF finances scholarship awards primarily through contributions from individuals, local golf and country clubs, alumni, corporations, and foundations.

NAMED AND ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIPS

Named and endowed scholarships give donors an opportunity to celebrate their commitment to education and golf. These special scholarships provide an enduring legacy for individuals, families and organizations to pay tribute to an individual or achievement.


