PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



THIS IS my first letter as president of the WGA Caddie Scholarship Fund. As a caddie scholar (Winged Foot 73-77) I am truly honored to lead this great organization. I can personally attest to our mission and how we have helped numerous individuals attain a college degree. You may be pleased to know that we have nine caddie scholar alumni who are Directors of the Fund. Our founders Mr. Udo Reinach and Mr. Willie Turnesa would be proud of this achievement.

This year's awarded class consisted of 41 new caddie scholars. For the 2021-2022 academic year we have a total of 205 caddie scholars attending 110 colleges and universities. These 205 scholars represent a tuition commitment of over \$900,000 for this academic year. The WGACSF has provided scholarships for 2,904 caddies, totaling \$24 million in aid since our founding in 1956.

We have set an ambitious agenda for the upcoming months, and I hope to share our results with you at the appropriate time. In the interim, we are developing programs

and initiatives to enhance the caddie scholar experience both during their college years and after graduation.

I would be remiss if I didn't mention the diligence and professionalism of our staff who work tirelessly in processing applications, running events and liaising with the colleges and universities. Without their dedication we quite simply couldn't exist.

Finally, I want to personally thank all of our supporters. Your generosity really does make a difference. You enable those in service to golf to attain a college degree. Education is truly a gift that keeps on giving.

OUR MISSION

The WGA Caddie Scholarship Fund (CSF) fosters the core values of personal responsibility, integrity and perseverance by giving young men and women in service to golf the opportunity to further enhance their lives through the pursuit of higher education. The Fund provides college scholarships to qualified candidates based on financial need.

OUR HISTORY

The WGA Caddie Scholarship Fund was established in 1956 by renowned amateur golfer Willie P. Turnesa and his good friend Udo Reinach. With 2,904 recipients since its founding, the Caddie Scholarship Fund has provided in excess of \$24,000,000 in scholarship funding.

OUR SCHOLARSHIPS

The CSF is one of the largest organizations of its kind in the nation. Caddie scholarship awards range from \$1,000 to \$10,000 per year for undergraduate study or for study at an accredited trade school. Maximum awards are awarded to exceptional students with exceptional need.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must demonstrate financial need, have applied to or currently attend an accredited school, and have worked a minimum of two seasons in service to golf at a local club in Bronx, Dutchess, Orange, Putnam, Rockland, Sullivan, Ulster, Westchester and Fairfield (CT) counties. Service to golf includes caddieing, golf course maintenance, and work in the golf shop, bag room or on the practice range. Club members and their children are not eligible to apply.

FUNDING

The CSF finances scholarship awards primarily through contributions from individuals, local golf and country clubs, alumni, corporations, and foundations.

NAMED AND ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIPS

Named and endowed scholarships give donors an opportunity to celebrate their commitment to education and golf. These special scholarships provide an enduring legacy for individuals, families and organizations to pay tribute to an individual or organization.

Since its inception, the CCH Caddie Scholarship has been awarded to 16 deserving caddies.

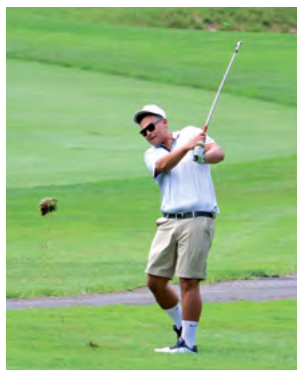

Clara and Daniel Assumma Memorial Scholarship
John Assumma, longtime General Manager of Waccabuc Country Club, established this scholarship in tribute to his parents. An annual family reunion tournament funded the scholarship. Joe Barreiro Scholarship Fund
Joe Barreiro, the longtime Caddie Master at Sleepy Hollow Country Club, retired in March 2018. Barreiro completed his first loop in 1965 at the Scarborough Club. When Barreiro retired, he was inducted into the national Caddie Hall of Fame. Joe retired after the 2017 season, but he is still a well known figure at Sleepy Hollow. In recognition of fifty-plus years of service, the membership of Sleepy Hollow made contributions in his honor to establish the Joe Barreiro Scholarship Fund. It couldn’t be a more fitting tribute. During Joe’s tenure, over 100 young men received scholarships to attend college and Joe received the Caddie Master of the Year award not once, but twice. Joe Germano Scholarship Fund

During the American Seniors Golf Association farewell dinner at the 2019 ASGA Summer Championship, Executive Director Kevin Patterson announced that the WGACSF would be the 2019 recipient of the Association's Charitable Trust contribution. The contribution

was intended to be the foundation of what would be an endowed scholarship in Joe Germano's name, in recognition of his many, many years of service to the game of golf, especially during his 22 year membership of the ASGA. Over the following days several members of the ASGA, Joe's friends and fellow Veterans all sent individual donations to his scholarship fund, quickly reaching and exceeding the endowment minimum.



Thomas M. Goff Memorial Scholarship Fund

Thomas "Tommy" M. Goff, CSF Class of 2007, passed away suddenly on March 30, 2019. A friend to many on and off of the golf course, this scholarship fund has been established by Tommy's friends and family to honor his legacy. Tommy was a member of the Police

Emerald Society, the Friendly Sons of St. Patrick, the International Association of Approved Basketball Officials, and a parishioner of the Monastery Church of the Sacred Heart. He was an active WGACSF Alumnus, having participated in many Alumni Reunion Outings and contributed annually.



Leonard M. Marx, Sr. Memorial Scholarship Fund

Leonard Marx, a graduate of Yale, was a commercial real estate developer in the New York metropolitan area. He and his wife, Virginia, were active philanthropists, in support of many charitable organizations and civic groups. Their daughter, Jennifer Gruenberg oversees the V & L Marx Foundation, which has

Paton Family Scholarship Fund

This fund was established in 2008, the first of the CSF's endowed program. Lee and Nancy Paton have been active officials at WGA, WMGA, USGA and LPGA competitions for many years. Nancy has served as president of the WMGA, has served on the USGA Women's

Mid-Am Committee and was Chairperson of the 2005 USGA Senior Women's Amateur. Lee served terms as president of both the WGA and the CSF and was presented with the Udo Reinach Award of Distinction in 2014. Awards from this fund are primarily for those in service to golf at The Apawamis Club.



William S. Perper Memorial Scholarship Fund

William Perper was a long time member of Westchester Country Club and a consistent supporter of the CSF. The fund was established in 2012, through a bequest from Mr. Perper's estate. Awards are made to caddies from Westchester Country Club.



Tom Nieporte, Sr. Memorial Scholarship Fund

Tom Nieporte was the longtime head golf professional at Winged Foot Golf Club. The position is widely known as one of the most prestigious positions in all of golf. Tom succeeded Claude Harmon, the legendary player and instructor, and held the position until

his retirement in 2006. His dedication and compassion to helping others was evident throughout his role at Winged Foot. He had a special commitment to the WGA Caddie Scholarship Fund. During his tenure, more than 100 caddies and others who worked in service to golf received scholarships to attend college. Tom passed away on December 21, 2014 and he is missed dearly by everyone privileged to know him. In keeping with Tom's love of golf and caddying, the Nieporte family established the *Tom Nieporte, Sr. Memorial Scholarship* in 2015 to be awarded to outstanding Winged Foot Golf Club caddies.



George J. Russ Memorial Scholarship Fund

George J. Russ, CSF Class of 1969, passed away in 2015 and left a significant gift to the Fund through his estate. In fact, it was the largest alumni contribution in the history of the CSF. George was a caddie at the Hudson River Club in Yonkers, NY and received a scholarship to

attend Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute. With the help of his family and friends, the George J. Russ Memorial Scholarship was established to pay tribute to George and pay it forward in a way that would have pleased him. In keeping with George's long and successful career in engineering, the scholarship is intended for caddies pursuing studies in the STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) fields.



Bob J. Thomas Scholarship Fund

assuming the role of president, a position he held from 2002-2006. The John Pinto Scholarship Fund was established shortly after his passing in 2020. Pinto's passion for the game and caddies will live on through the endowed scholarship in his name.

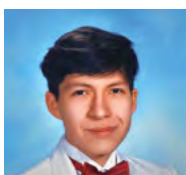

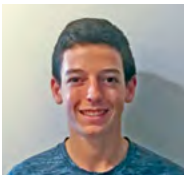

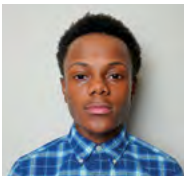
